Dear Sublette Center Families,

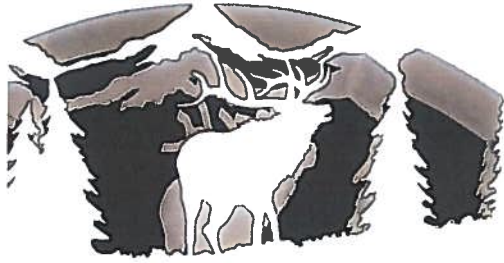
I wanted to take a minute to update you with regards to visitation. As many of you are aware, nursing homes across the state are opening up to limited visitation. We hope to join them very soon, however, due to the amount of positive testing in our county, we are only accommodating compassionate care visitation at this time. At the time of this writing, Sublette County has a 13.9% positivity rate. What that means is that 13.9% of people who get tested end up with a positive result. Until that percentage is less than 10%, we cannot open to regular visitation.

For now, all residents and staff are being tested once per week, and we are open to compassionate visitation only.

However, I'd like to take a minute to provide some education regarding what visitation will look like here when we do get to open.

Outdoor visitation remains the safest option per CDC recommendations. We will be utilizing that as much as possible. When winter finally hits (any day now), we will be opening to indoor visitation provided the following:

1. That county positivity rate is less than 10%
2. There are no cases in the facility among residents or staff
3. Visitors will be limited in terms of people visiting each resident (1-2 adults) and in terms of the number of visitors in the facility as a whole. Therefore, visits will need to be scheduled with the Activities Department 307-367-4161 x 121.
4. Visitors coming into the facility will need a negative COVID test, will need to be in good health (no fever, no cough, no other symptoms of acute illness), and will need to adhere to CDC guidelines for social distancing, mask wearing and hand washing. If you cannot adhere to the CDC guidelines for some reason, we will be happy to assist with virtual visits for you and your loved one.
5. Visits will occur off the medical wing (such as chapel) whenever possible to limit the exposure for other residents.
